



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

of the online auction www.auctionnonviolence.org

1. The auction is to the benefit of the The Non-Violence Project Foundation (NVPF) to fight violence is a charity sale.
2. All of the funds collected will be donated to NVPF to increase the number of beneficiaries of its programs, in order to prevent domestic violence and cyber harassment in particular, which have exploded as a result of the confinement linked to Covid19.
3. Bidders must be of legal age.
4. The sale by auction will be pronounced in favor of the last and highest online bidder, on the date and time registered in the online sales catalog.
5. The auction takes place exclusively online. When the starting price is not reached, the lot will remain unsold.
6. To bid on www.auctionnonviolence.org, the bidder must send an email to the following address: auction@nonviolence.com specifying the bidder's surname, first name, city of residence, telephone number and email address.
7. Information under section 6, above, is strictly confidential. It will only be used for the purpose of this auction and will not be used for any other purpose.
8. NVPF cannot be held responsible for any internet malfunction that would disrupt the smooth running of the auctions.
9. All purchases must be expressly settled within three days of the end of the online auction sale.
10. Payment will be made on invoice, which will be sent by email to the purchaser by NVPF for payment on receipt.
11. No lot will be awarded before full payment of the sale price.
12. If more than one bidder declares to place a joint auction offer, they are jointly and severally liable for the obligations towards NVPF.
13. All items are sold according to the description given in the catalog of the sale.
14. At the end of the auction's closing and the full settlement of the lots, the items will be sent by NVPF. Free delivery in Europe except special cases mentioned. Outside Europe, transport and customs costs, if any, will be charged to the buyer.



15. NVPF cannot be held responsible for any claim on the part of an auction participant or successful bidders concerning the organization and conditions of the sale.
16. The presentation of the items has been carried out in a meticulous manner and with care by the authorized persons. No claim will be accepted once the payment has been made.
17. Foreign buyers must check, before the sale is completed, to comply with the import and export regulations between Switzerland and the country of destination.
18. The bidder's personal data will only be used for the auction. They will then be deleted, unless otherwise agreed by the bidder.
19. Access to personal data is exclusively limited to the people in charge of implementing this auction.
20. A tax receipt issuance will be subject to the applicable tax legislation.
21. The Geneva Cantonal Tax Administration has been informed of this auction.
22. Any litigation related to the online auction is subject to Swiss law and Geneva court jurisdiction whatever the domicile of the parties.
